

APPRENTICE/STUDENT HURTMAN RESCUE

Overview: Event to simulate lineman was hurt.

Using a Ox block the apprentice will secure mannequin and lower to the ground having two full wraps/3 clicks on the Ox block. Time stops when mannequin is on the ground with the rope slacked. Each apprentice/student has five minutes to ask questions and adjust belts prior to the start of the event.

The hand-line may not be repositioned during the setup.

The event judge will position the hand-line the same way for each contestant, the hook shall be at the "Ox-Block".

Time starts at the judge's signal with the apprentice standing at an arm's length from the pole wearing **leather work gloves** with gauntlet (No driving gloves etc.).

The apprentice's belt and hooks will be lying on the ground beside him an arm's length from the pole, safety strap snapped into D-ring and belt unbuckled.

No belt will be allowed to be placed on or around the pole.

Judges use a 3" PVC conduit between the rope and the mannequin to evaluate.

Exceeding 4 minutes to complete the event will result in a Two-point deduction.

Note: Video will not be considered when a contestant wants to challenge the judge's ruling. Challenges need to be made while the contestant is at that event. The contestant leaving the event implies agreement with the judge's ruling.
