

APPRENTICE/STUDENT OBSTACLE RELAY

Overview: Transferring Apparatus to adjacent side

Questions can be directed to the judge 5 minutes before the event begins. Apprentice/ student will be tooled up and prepared to ascend the pole. The clock starts when the judge says “**GO**”. The climber will climb up and transfer the grip, deadend insulator, and the insulator on the pin to the opposite side, in any order. Once everything has been transferred, climb down. Time stops when the climbers’ first foot hits the ground.

Deductions: 2 Points per infraction

- Miss use of tools and equipment
- Running handline while climbing
- Dropping anything to ground
- Gaffing out/ Losing control (Both Gaffs Out)
- Lack of PPE
- Not transferring apparatus
- Grip not extended all the way on neutral

Contestants must wear 100% fall protection at all times!

Note: Video will not be considered when a contestant wants to challenge the judge’s ruling. Challenges need to be made while the contestant is at that event. The contestant leaving the event implies agreement with the judge’s ruling.
